Details: This position will be responsible for carrying out direct case management activities; including assessment of family issues, supporting family visits, competency skill development, utilization of community resources and the family's support network. The worker helps families in goal planning and utilizes a range of intervention strategies and counseling to help address the issues the family is facing. The worker may also be involved in facilitating groups. Working with other providers on the service team the family worker helps the family in addressing risk that brought them to the attention of the department.
