Details: This position is responsible for providing facilitation of the “Prevention Conversation” material to community groups and other professionals to increase awareness of FASD and the effects of using alcohol during pregnancy.

This is a temporary position until September 2023, with the possibility of extension.

Hours: Shift times and days will vary per week; **total of 28 hours per week.**

Hours will typically range between Monday to Friday 8:30am—4:30pm.

A flexible schedule is required as this role may include some evenings and weekends as needed.
