### The Supported Independent Living Program for Youth Requires a: LIVE-IN SUPPORT WORKER

**Details:** *Please note that this position requires that you live on site as your main residence.*

This position is ideal for students or young professionals in the field of Human Services wanting to gain further experience in the field, while living rent free in an apartment within a building that supports youth ages 16-22 living in their own apartments.

The Live-In Support worker is responsible for providing support to the youth and crisis management between the hours of 11:00pm and 7:00am nightly. The Live-In Support Worker has every other weekend off. The first two hours of each shift are awake and the remaining six hours are sleep hours, allowing the Live-In Support Worker to go to school or work elsewhere during the day. There are on site Transitional Support Workers during the weekdays and early evenings as well as 24 hour on call support.

The position requires a strong ability to connect with and develop helping relationships, teach daily living skills, support and offer guidance, complete nightly documentation and participate in on-going program development. Confidence and experience in crisis management is required. The ideal candidate possesses strong written and verbal communication skills. Most importantly the ideal candidate has a passion for working with youth and wanting to see them succeed.

**Hours:** Sunday through Saturday 11:00pm—7:00am; (2 awake hours & 6 sleep hours per night) and **every second weekend** from Friday at 7:00 am to Sunday at 11:00 pm off.

- ◆ Six (6) months of directly related experience in youth/family work
- ◆ Equivalencies may be considered

- ◆ Emergency First Aid—Level C CPR + AED
