Details: This position will assist 3 male adults with mental health disorders, developmental disabilities, complex behaviors, high risk issues and substance abuse. The adults require support to foster community relationships, daily living skills, decision making using a best practice approach to help people to transition to a greater degree of independence and healthy lifestyle choices.

Hours: The hours for this position will vary and can include daytime, weekends, evenings, **and an emphasis on awake overnights and morning availability**. Shifts will be 8 hours or 12 hours in length. This position requires the employee to work a minimum of 16 hours per month.
